December 4, 2001**

Meeting Notes

1. Welcome and Introductions

A brief presentation was made by Healthy San Diego staff and Health Plan representatives.** Evalyn Greb also described the staff activity with the health plans and Data/Finance Workgroup and Planning Committee members over the last two months. Discussion followed regarding the potential of Healthy San Diego expansion as the LTCIP service delivery model. It was offered and accepted that Leslie Hine-Rabichow convene a providers workgroup for the community-based organizations to begin to prepare for participation in LTCIP implementation.

Bob Prath reported that he had been part of a national meeting where he learned that, using the national percentages, San Diego County is estimated to have spent \$760M treating medication mismanagement last fiscal year. He wants to see LTCIP implement a managed care system in which physicians are aware of all an individual's medications across providers.

Betty London was not able to attend but forwarded an e-mail asking when and where AARP representatives could provide support and advocacy for implementation of LTCIP in San Diego.

Greg Knoll also stated that the Center for Health education and Advocacy wants to advocate for LTCIP implementation.
